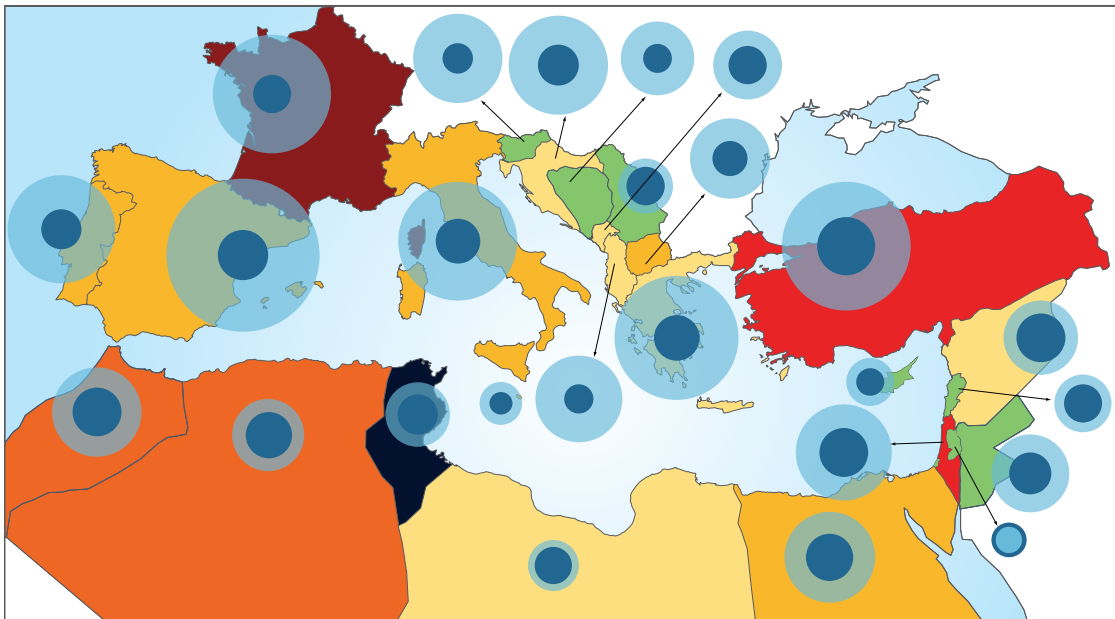
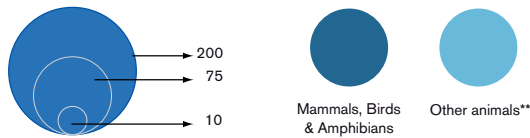


MAP A.8 | Threatened Species in the Mediterranean



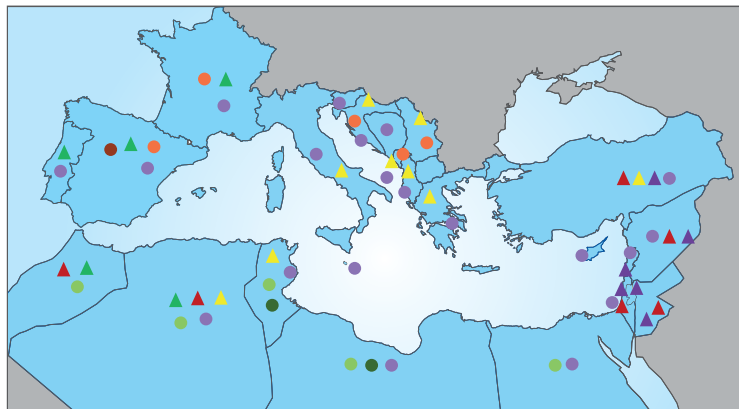
