

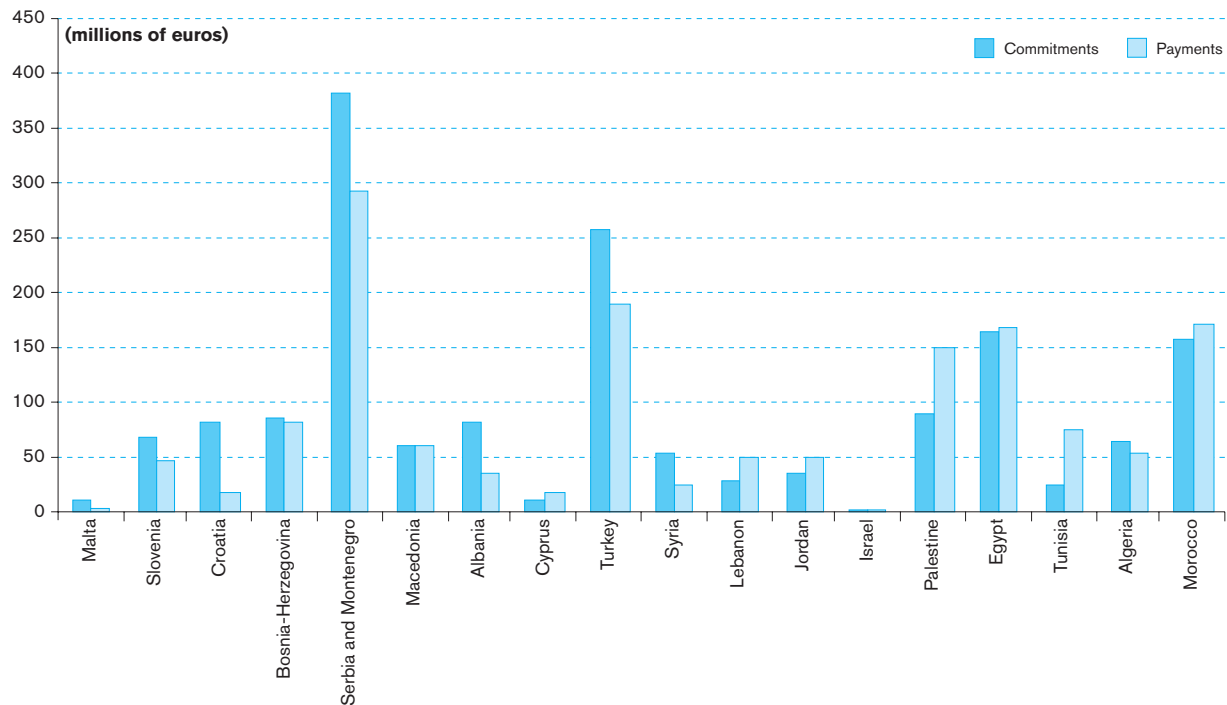

**GRAPHIC A1** EU Cooperation 2004

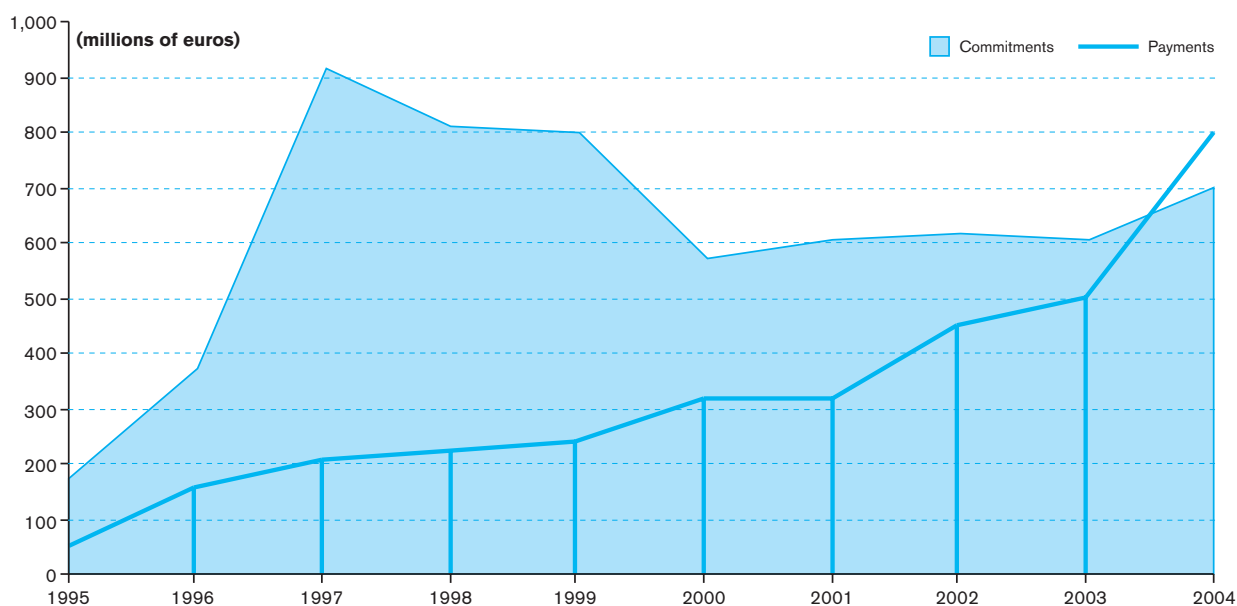
