

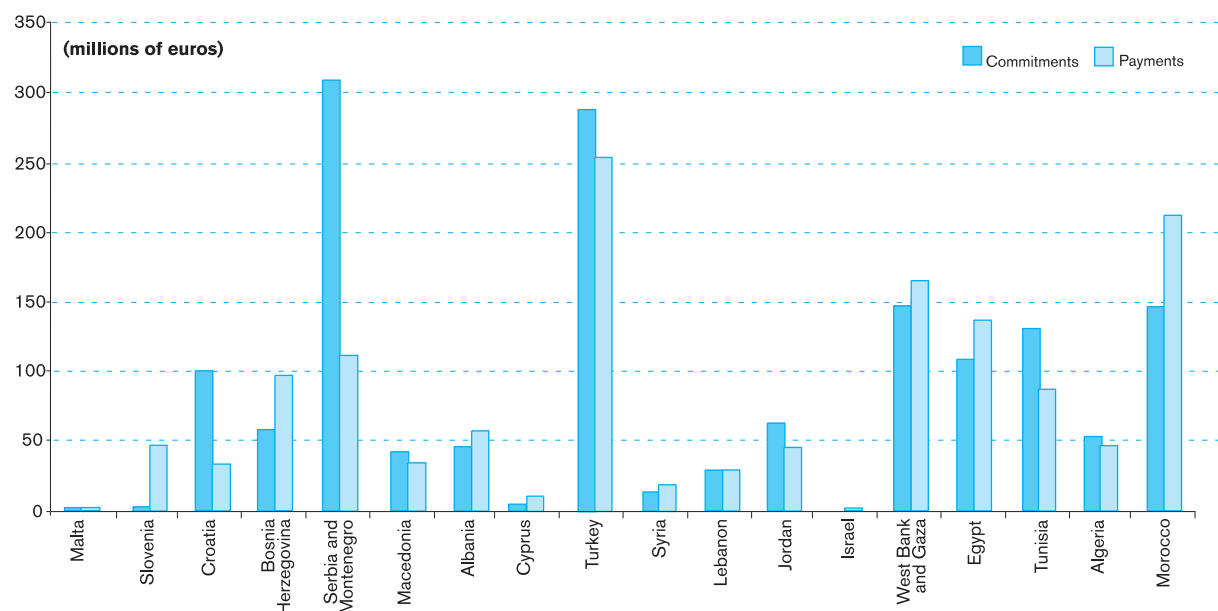

GRAPHIC A1 EU Cooperation 2005

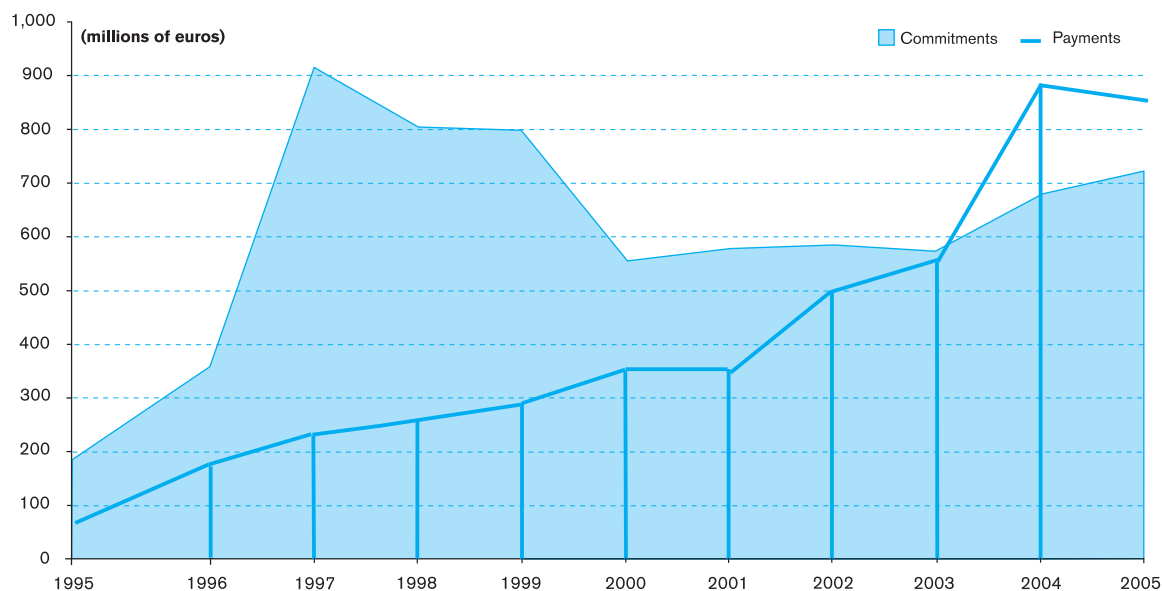
