



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


CHART F3 Evolution of urban agglomerations of more than 750,000 inhabitants (1950-2005)




CHART F4 Public expenditure on education (1999-2005*)









Adolescent fertility rate (births per 1,000 women ages 15-19) (2005)






CHART F8 Female participation in the national parliaments (% seats in Parliament held by women) (1997-2007)

















Importance of aquaculture in the Mediterranean (selection of countries with aquaculture production higher than 100,000 mt) (2005)










CHART F15 Employment rate, >15 years, by genders (%) (2005)










Evolution of per capita CO₂ emissions (mt) (1990-2004)












Evolution of tourism (1990-2005)*






