Uncertain state due to the collapse of the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya in 2011. In October 2020, a permanent ceasefire was signed to end the war. A government of national unity was formed which was to hold power until general elections were held. However, the elections were postponed indefinitely and the House of Representatives appointed the former Interior Minister, Fathi Bashaga. This ushered in a new period of institutional paralysis and political confrontation between Prime Minister Dbeibeh's NGU and Prime Minister Basghaga's new National Stability Government.
